## **Caroline Robert, MD, PhD (Chair)**

Caroline Robert is the head of the Dermatology Unit at Gustave Roussy and co-director of the Melanoma Research Unit at INSERM 981 Paris-Sud University in Villejuif, France. She chaired the melanoma group of the European Organisation for Research and Treatment of Cancer from 2014 to 2017, and she is a board member of EADO, the European Society for Medical Oncology (ESMO), the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology, the French Society of Dermatology and Venereology, the American Society of Clinical Oncology, and the American Association for Cancer Research.



## **Reinhard Dummer, MD**

Professor Reinhard Dummer is a professor at the University of Zurich and vice-chairman of the Department of Dermatology at the University Hospital of Zurich, Switzerland. Currently he is head of the Skin Cancer Unit and the Clinical Trial Unit of the Department of Dermatology. He was president of the Melanoma Project Group of the Swiss Institute for Applied Cancer Research from 1999 to 2016 and is a member of the German National Academy of Sciences (Leopoldina); in addition, he was a board member of the Society for Melanoma Research and past president of the International Society for Cutaneous Lymphomas. He is a founding and board member of EADO, ESMO, and the University of Zurich's University Research Priority Project on Translational Cancer Research and past president of the European Society for Dermatological Research.



## **Axel Hauschild, MD**

Professor Axel Hauschild is head of the Skin Cancer Working Group at the University Hospital Schleswig-Holstein, Campus Kiel, Germany. His main clinical interests are the diagnosis and treatment of melanoma and nonmelanoma skin cancer. He has been the principal investigator of more than 100 phase 1-3 clinical trials on melanoma, cutaneous lymphomas, and epithelial skin cancers. He is the past president of the German Dermatologic Cooperative Oncology Group and board member of EADO and the Melanoma World Society. Professor Hauschild was the president of the 8th World Congress of Melanoma in Hamburg (2013) and is the designated president of the 10th World Congress of Melanoma, to be held in Rome in April 2021.
